Sudhakara, Head, Department of Mathematics, spoke about the greatness of Srinivasa Ramanujan, the Brilliant Mathematician, who was born on 1887 to a Tamil

Brahmin Iyengar family in Erode, Tamil Nadu. Aryabhata, Brahmagupta, Mahavira, Bhaskara II, Srinivasa Ramanujan and Other ancient scholars made significant Contributions to Mathematics. Srinivasa Ramanujan demonstrated the signs of a developing genius at his young age. His Contributions to Fractions, Infinite Series, Number Theory, Mathematical Analysis and other areas set a precedent in Mathematics. The Programme was presided over by Dr. E. Sudhakara, Head, Department of Mathematics. The Students and Staff of the College attended the programme and made it a grand success.

Principal of the college Dr. C. Yoganjaneyulu had been invited as chief guest and vice-principal Dr. S. Sugunamma as guest of honour. They applauded the service of Savithribai Phule and asked the students to follow her scrupulously. While participating in the programme as a speaker, B.Gangadhar, Head, Department of History had given a brief history about her. Savitribai Phule was the wife of Jyotiba Phule, a social reformer who attacked the brahmanical dominance in the caste hierarchy. She became an active member of Sathya Sodhak Samaj and founded the first girls school in Pune and is considered the first women teacher in India. To commemorate her name, Government of India started to celebrate her birthday as Women Teachers' Day on 3rd January every year.



NATIONAL VOTERS' DAY

25th January 2022: The NSS volunteers and Department of Political Science celebrated the National Voters' Day on 25th January 2022. The Principal of the college, Dr. C. Yoganjaneyulu, attended the event as a Chief Guest and emphasized that there is an urgent need of bringing awareness among the citizens about their voting rights. Smt.
